Other services:

- Bleeding time test: \$29.33 (certain dog breeds are predisposed to a bleeding disorder, this would check the time it takes for them to clot prior to surgery)
- Laser treatment: \$10.43 (a light therapeutic laser can be used after the surgery to speed up the cell's metabolism and shorten the typical healing time)
- Microchip: \$43.98 (registered with HomeAgain)
- Retained deciduous tooth extraction: pricing variable (Baby teeth do not always fall out on their own. If a deciduous tooth and an adult tooth are occupying the same space, it could lead to further dental disease)
- Pre anesthetic bloodwork: roughly \$80-\$150 varies depending on how extensive blood work wanted is (determine the safety of the anesthetic based on the patient's organ function)
- IV catheter / fluids: \$95.22 (allows the patient to stay hydrated and stabilize blood pressure throughout surgery)
- E-collar: price variable depending on size on pet (cone which inhibits pets from scratching, licking, or otherwise messing with their incision site)

<u>Please note:</u> It is required for all pets to be up to date on preventive health care before performing surgery. This includes an annual exam, appropriate vaccinations, as well as yearly diagnostic tests.
